# Blended Learning



Content is given as “homework” + required scheduled online meetings with the supervising local teacher



Students, working individually at home, have the opportunity to express opinions, open up for critical thinking for the class activities as well as resolve any questions



Individual progress can be made with the possibility of learning at own time, speed and way (especially for accelerated plan when well guided)

# What does it take to make it work?

- Equipment needed: PC or Laptop, camera and mic
- Students committed and involved with the program

- Optional weekly tutoring
- “Optimize” the face-to-face moment, applying theory/content with classroom practices, projects, dynamics and games
- Master the dynamic of multi-level students in a single classroom

- ✓ Vaccination records (in English)



# Who can participate in the program?



## High School

- ❖ Level of English equivalent to **B2**
  - ❖ Placement Test by Flex Major (paid per test according to contract)
  - ❖ Proven by another international test, held in up to 2 years
  - ❖ Despite the minimum level, the higher the student's level of English is, the easier the program will be.

## Middle School

- ❖ Level of English equivalent to **B1**
  - ❖ Placement Test by Flex Major (paid per test according to contract)
  - ❖ Proven by another international test, held in up to 2 years
  - ❖ Despite the minimum level, the higher the student's level of English is, the easier the program will be.

## Deadline and extracurricular dedication

- ❖ The program is scheduled to be completed in 3 years
- ❖ Students study approximately 6 hours per week individually or have 6 hours of weekly required classes with our tutors
- ❖ A minimum of 45 minutes per week of online meetings with coaches is required in any case
- ❖ Face-to-face classes: in addition to dynamics to promote the practice of speaking among students from debates, they have written evaluation activities (TSTs).
- ❖ They take for homework readings, and multiple choice activities (quizzes and CSTs).
- ❖ Coaches monitor the student's progress online.
